Attention is also drawn to the following extracts from the Irish Aviation Authority (Nationality and Registration of Aircraft) Order, 2015:-

- 10(3) A Certificate of registration shall not be transferable and, if it becomes void, shall, unless accidentally destroyed, be returned without delay to the Authority by the person having custody or possession thereof.
- 15(1) Where a change takes place in the ownership of an aircraft registered in the State or the requirements of Article 7 of this Order for registration in the State cease to be fulfilled in respect of such aircraft, the registered owner at the time of that change or cesser shall forthwith notify the Authority of the change or cesser.
 - (2) A person who becomes the owner of an aircraft registered in the State shall forthwith notify the Authority of the fact.
- 16(1) The registered owner of an aircraft registered in the State which is destroyed or permanently withdrawn from use shall forthwith upon such destruction or withdrawal notify the Authority thereof and return or cause to be returned to the Authority the certificate of registration of the aircraft unless such certificate has been accidentally destroyed.
- *Definition of Registered Owner as set out in the Irish Aviation Authority (Nationality and Registration of Aircraft) Order, 2015:-

'Registered Owner' means the person or persons in whose name an aircraft is registered and includes, where any such person is deceased, such persons legal personal representative, or, in the case of a company, the successor in title of the company.

It should be noted that the "Registered Owner" may not be the legal owner.
